B. This agreement is a legally binding instrument when signed by the student and accepted by the school. Your signature on this agreement acknowledges that you have been given a reasonable time to read and understand it and that you have been given: (a) a written statement of the refund policy including examples of how it applies; and (b) a catalog including a description of the course or educational service including all material facts concerning the school and the program or course of instruction which are likely to affect your decision to enroll. Upon signing this agreement, you will be given a copy of it to retain.

C. **Course Units and Description:**

A total of 96 quarter units are required to complete the entire ministerial training program and the Master of Arts in Consciousness Studies degree.

D. **Buyer's Right to Cancel:**

The student has a right to cancel this enrollment agreement in any manner and obtain a refund within 30 days. You may cancel this enrollment agreement and receive a refund as specified in the Student Catalog by notifying your Regional Center or the Administrative Office in the case of Distance Education courses.

**F. Refund Information:**

Students may cancel enrollment at any time and in any manner.. If a student cancels before midnight on the fifth business day after course materials are mailed, he/she will receive a refund of all monies paid. Students are required to study a minimum of one audio lesson per week during the ten-week quarter. If a student decides to withdraw from the course after five business days, but before the end of the enrollment period, the refund will be calculated as follows:

If the student has completed:

- a. Up to and including 10% of the course, he/she will be responsible for the registration fee and 10% of the remaining tuition.
- b. Between 10% and 25% of the course, he/she will be responsible for the registration fee and 25% of the remaining tuition.
- c. Between 25% and 50% of the course, he/she will be responsible for the registration fee and 50% of the remaining tuition.
- d. After the student has completed more than half the course, he/she is responsible for 100% of the course tuition.

If the student's enrollment agreement is not accepted, he/she will receive a full tuition refund. All refunds are made within 30 days of receipt of request for withdrawal.

**Example:** If there are 10 lessons in a 3-unit distance education course and the student completes 1 lesson:  $1 \text{ divided by } 10 = 10\% \text{ completed}$ . Thus:  $\$389.00 \text{ minus non-refundable registration fee of } \$50.00 = \$339.00 \times .90 = \$305.10 \text{ to be refunded}$ .

**Payment:** **Payment in full for all courses is due upon registration.**

Registering for any Fall 2008 class certifies that I have read, understood, and agreed to my rights and responsibilities, and that the institution's cancellation and refund policies have been clearly explained to me.

Processing of any registration for any Fall 2008 class certifies acceptance of this contract by the Holmes Institute and is legally binding.
